Please confirm this bullet should be addressed in the Project Experience Tab and not Tab 4 Firm and Proposed Team Approach.	Please provide the requested information as is in the RFP.
3.	In the RFP, under the technical proposal, Section 3.1, <b>Tab 7. Additional Information</b> , it states the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The firm must also provide electronic copies or license numbers regarding the following certifications:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ 1. Certificate of Authorization from the State Education Department to provide architectural/engineering services in NYS.</li><li>▪ 2. NYS Licensed/Professional Architect/Engineer.</li><li>▪ 3. Accredited American Institute of Certified Planners (A.I.C.P.).</li></ul></li></ul> Does DASNY need these items from just the prime – or also from the subconsultants as well?
